



Professor Ebru Kale Vice Rector

Born in Ankara in 1975, she completed her primary, secondary, and high school education in Ankara. She received her medical degree from Ankara University Faculty of Medicine between 1992 and 1998.

Between 2001 and 2005, she completed her residency training in the Department of Medical Biochemistry at Dicle University Faculty of Medicine. She served as an Assistant Professor in the same department from 2006 to 2010 and was awarded the title of Associate Professor in 2011.

Between 2010 and 2012, she worked at Adana Maternity and Children's Hospital, and between 2012 and 2018, she served as an educational and administrative supervisor at Kocaeli Derince Training and Research Hospital.

In April 2018, she was appointed as a Professor in the Department of Medical Biochemistry at University of Health Sciences Faculty of Medicine and assigned to Kartal Dr. Lütfi Kırdar Training and Research Hospital.

On September 9, 2019, she was appointed as Vice Dean of University of Health Sciences Hamidiye Faculty of Medicine and served in this position until October 2025. During this period, she also held the positions of Head of the Department of Medical Biochemistry at both Hamidiye Faculty of Medicine and Hamidiye International Faculty of Medicine, Head of the Basic Medical Sciences Department, and member of the Faculty Board and Faculty Executive Board.

Between 2022 and 2024, she served as Dean of University of Health Sciences Hamidiye Faculty of Pharmacy.

In 2025, she served as Chair of the Hamidiye Ethics Committee for Non-Interventional Research Involving Pharmaceuticals and Medical Devices.

As of October 2025, she has been serving as Vice Rector of University of Health Sciences. She has numerous publications and scientific presentations in national and international peer-reviewed journals and conferences. She currently serves as Editor of Hamidiye Medical Journal.

Her research focuses on clinical biochemistry, particularly the biochemical basis of metabolic diseases, diagnostic biomarkers, and laboratory medicine.
