DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION:

- 1. "Certificate of Equivalence" to be obtained from the Turkish Embassy, Consulate or Provincial Directorates of National Education showing that the high school diploma is equivalent to the diplomas obtained from Turkish High Schools.
- 2. Original high school diploma or provisional graduation certificate and its Turkish translation certified by a notary public or Turkish Foreign Representative Office (If it's in English, translation is not required).
- **3.** Original TR-YÖS Exam Result Certificate valid for the registration of the candidate to the programmes of domestic academic units.
- **4.** A copy of the pages of the passport showing the identity information and validity period and the Turkish translation certified by a notary public or Turkish Foreign Representative Office (if in English, no translation is required).
- **5.** Certificate of residence (must be submitted within one month from the date of registration).
- **6.** Original bank receipt showing that the tuition fee has been paid.
- 7. Signed livelihood security declaration form showing that the candidates have sufficient financial security to continue their higher education and make a living in our country (the form will be obtained from our university).
- **8.** Visa, visa exemption or residence permit with a validity period of at least 60 days or more.
- 9. Six 4.5×6 cm passport size photographs, (must have been taken within the last six months, from the front facade, in a way that can easily identify the candidate).
- 10. A medical report signed by a single physician indicating the candidate's state of health.
- 11. Certificate Copy of an Entry from Dual Citizens who are foreign nationals by birth and who have later acquired Turkish Citizenship.
- 12. Students under the age of 18 who have not entered Türkiye with a student visa are required to submit a notarized letter of consent signed by both parents, explicitly granting permission for the student to study and reside in Türkiye. In such cases, an official birth certificate is also mandatory.
- 13. International students who register at the university may apply for insurance to be covered by the General Health Insurance within three months from their initial enrolment date, provided they pay the insurance premiums themselves.
- 14. Applications of those who make false statements, provide falsified, forged, incomplete or incorrect documents during the application, placement and registration process will be rejected. If these candidates are registered, they will be cancelled regardless of the semester they are studying. Necessary legal proceedings are initiated against those whose actions and activities constitute a crime.
- 15. Language Proficiency Levels of students placed in programs within the academic units of our university are subject to the principles of the University of Health Sciences Foreign Language and Turkish Preparatory Class Education and Examination Directive, and the following conditions are valid.

- **a)** Students who are entitled to be placed in the programmes with TR-YÖS2024 or TR-YÖS2025 exam and who score 60 out of 100 for English and **C1** for Turkish in the Language Proficiency Examination (YDYS) are exempt from the compulsory Foreign Language and Turkish preparatory class.
- **b)** Those who get a score of 60 for English and C1 for Turkish from the central national exams conducted by ÖSYM or those who get the score determined by the Senate from international exams accepted as equivalent by ÖSYM are exempt from the compulsory Foreign Language and Turkish preparatory class.
